## Gender Sensitization Programmes:

Gender Sensitization course is aimed at introducing students to different dimensions of gender issues. It is a non-credit course introduced by JNTU, Hyderabad and is taught by the faculty of English, Department of Freshman Engineering. The course highlights varying issues of all genders and sensitises the students to handle these issues delicately. The primary goal is to understand the contributions of all the genders in the shaping of a balanced social setup. The syllabus of this course includes issues concerning the relationship between men and women, caste, declining sex ratio, gender stereotyping, and struggles with discrimination, sexual harassment, new forums for justice, eve-teasing, and others. Besides, women's contribution in history is given least importance as history is recorded by the men from their perspective. Most of the times thus, the course also introduces the students to the epoch-making contributions of some great women in India.

Through this course, students are encouraged to participate in debates and discussions on gender issues. A variety of activities are planned in order to spread awareness in society about gender issues through the students, such as visits to NGOs, poster making and awareness campaigns.

To enhance the skill set in the integrated course, the students are advised to execute course-based design projects. Some sample projects are given below:
