**Report on Road Safety Awareness Programme**

**Date: 29 January 2020**

The Road Safety Awareness Programme was hosted by the department of Freshman Engineering on 29 January 2020. Mr. G. Narayan Reddy, the Circle Inspector of Police, Shamshabad traffic Police Station was the speaker for the programme. The programme was organised in view of the Road Safety Week observed every year during 27<sup>th</sup> January and 2<sup>nd</sup> February.



During his talk, the Circle Inspector gave statistical information on the number of deaths caused by accidents in India and said that India has about 1.2 Lakhs of deaths in road accidents per annum. He also discussed the major reasons behind the accidents, they are, human error, the condition of the vehicle and the condition of the road. Besides, he mentioned that there is lack of awareness about the motor vehicle rules among majority of the people. He expressed his concern about people riding without helmet and triple seat bike riders.

Mr. Narayan Reddy further discussed the measures that should be taken by people to avoid road mishaps. He said a valid license and registration of the vehicle is mandatory. In addition, the helmet must have an ISI mark. Use of mobile phones while driving must strictly be avoided.



He also informed that driving in an inebriated state is extremely dangerous. In addition to these, he informed that the police are making the enforcement of rules stricter than before and that there will be immediate actions on those who disobey the traffic rules. He also informed about the different amounts of fine for breaking of rules.



He concluded his session by appealing to the students to be cautious while using a vehicle on the road.
